2013 Ridgway Rifle Club Monthly IDPA Matches

<u>Dates and Times:</u> We have been holding our matches on the second Saturday of each month. There has been occasions (up to twice a year) when we have had to move the match date, so if you are traveling from any distance or haven't attended in some time please verify the date through one of the range officers listed at the bottom of this page. Matches begin at 10:00AM, and sign up or registration begins at 9:00. Completion of the match is usually about 2:00-3:-00PM. We shoot year round, and during inclement weather we use the indoor range, and when possible we use the outdoor pistol range.

Entry Fee: \$10 is our fee for the match. For this price we also have been providing a small lunch consisting of sandwiches, chips and drinks, and sometimes a few extras donated by some of our match attendees.

<u>What to Bring:</u> Eye and ear protection is mandatory. The minimum needed would be your sidearm, a holster (belt type, no shoulder, ankle, or chest rigs are permitted), spare magazines, speedloaders, approximately 100 rounds of ammo, and a concealment garment such as a jacket or vest. Magazine or speedloader pouches are recommended if you have them but you may load from you pockets.

Rules and General Information: We run a cold range meaning that all firearms are unloaded and holstered until the shooter is on the line. We have been operating as a non-affiliated IDPA club, so an IDPA membership is not required. We do not give out any prizes of awards. Match scoring is done through e-mail, so a valid e-mail address is required to obtain your match results. IDPA is a defensive style combat pistol match with its own set of rules that are too numerous to mention here, but can be obtained from this web address under about IDPA on the upper left hand side of the page: http://www.idpa.com/. We strive to run the match with an enjoyable, relaxed, and lenient atmosphere but we feel that (as most ranges do) it is the shooters responsibility to learn the rules of IDPA and to observe safe gun handling skills while attending the matches. Also, it is greatly appreciated when anyone attending the match helps with pasting, setting targets, and scoring.
